The district governor will qualify for the 2008-09 Presidential Citation if at least 50 percent of the clubs in the district qualify for a citation *and* the governor and at least 50 percent of the district's club presidents have brought a new member into Rotary between 1 July 2008 and 31 March 2009. Eligible governors will receive a certificate of recognition from the president for this achievement.
